

The RBGC model: Process

Project work plan and activities in selected topics

 Carried out in close cooperation with experts and sectoral authorities (e.g. logistics, MaaS, commuting)

Stakeholder communication process

- Project results communicated and tested
- Observes the policy-making environments on EU, national and local levels (e.g. transport, regional development).
- Triple-helix structure to gain highest credibility (public, private, research)

Policy-making process

- Incorporates key outcomes and conclusions, as applicable and feasible.
- Political processes on transnational, national, local levels.
- Formal and informal stakeholder relations.
